Minutes of the meeting :-

- 1) The Director Meghe group Mr. Abha Meghe initiated the meet with introduction of all the dignitaries and EPTA members.
- 2) The Chairperson Ms. Karita Nagarajan initiated power point presentation by feeling pride to be the part of Meghe group.

Vision and Mission were shared to all the EPTA members. She shared Awards related to Meghe group. Also was proud to announce SOS, Waradongri to be the

first school in central India to get NABET certified.

Initiation of Atal Lab in all sister concern school was also shared by the chairperson.

- 3) She explained about skill integrated Activities - NEP 2020 and Best practices - Online school initiated by the teachers eg Mind map, ppts, flipped classroom, Learning by doing etc were explained in the meet.
- 4) Teacher and students online interaction with new tools were appreciated by the chairperson. We are exposed to national and international awards. SOS Atley got best school online teaching award.
- 5) She also focused on ongoing activities, also achievement class self paced classes, international collaboration, student led Conference, India MGS, Competitions, remedial classes etc.
- 6) Student council - prefectorial board participate in all the activities actively - Christmas fest.
- 7) Future initiatives by SOS, Wanadongri like Artificial Intelligence.
- 8) Safety and security - CCTV cameras, guards.
Online School - Parents feedback - appreciated teaching and learning process.
- 9) Achievement - Miss Chintala got 2nd prize (Art) cash of 30,000. 1st prize in Bal Kala - Meghe group.
Helen Dhaipure got 1st prize in Science competition organised by Raman Science Centre.
MLIN - SOS Wana Scholars MLIN initiated by Alumni Art camp, Christmas fest '21 (Nur, KG I, KG II) - Different activities were

- 10) Chairperson appealed for outstanding fees. as on 22nd Dec '21. She explained easy fee EMI - An initiative to support parents for paying outstanding fees for the session 2019-2020. 2020-2021.

11) The Management at school has informed to the EPTA members, that as a difficulty raised due to prevailing Covid-19 Pandemic in resumption and conducting of physical classes in the school, though a fee increase of 7.5 % over the interim fees applicable for the academic year 2019-20 was approved for the academic year 2020-21 to 2021-22, but the school Management has not increased the approved interim fee increase of 7.5 % for the academic session 2019-20.

Considering the fact that the Covid-19 pandemic has had its damaging effect on the financial condition of several families and to enable the parents to ensure a smooth flow of education of their wards and regular payment of fees to the school, the management has considered the request of parents sympathetically and has granted a waiver of 10 % in the interim fees for the Academic Year - 2020-21.

Further to above, the management has allowed further a waiver of 7.5 % equal to approved increase in the interim fees for the academic year 2021-22 solely on humanitarian grounds.

12) Feedback was taken from the present EPTA members, the same was praise worthy in regards of the online school teaching and learning process. Further they also appreciated the initiation taken by the school for ensuring the safety and security of the children while running physical school, strictly following all COVID - protocols.

13) In case of fees increase approval by EPTA :-

a) School management has proposed the increase in school fees by 15 % over the fees applicable for the academic year 2021-22.

The above proposal has been considered by the Executive Parents Teachers Association (hereinafter referred to as "EPTA"), keeping in mind the various factors mentioned in section 9 of the Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Regulation of fees) Act, 2011 (hereinafter referred to as "said Act") and has approved and agreed for 10% over the fees applicable for the Academic Year 2021-22. This approved fees will be applicable for the academic sessions 2022-23 and 2023-24.

As of now, proceedings are pending before DRFC relating to the increase of fees for the year 2019-20 and therefore, presently the increase is being proposed on the fees agreed by the EPTA during the EPTA meetings for deciding the increase in fees for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22. In case any order is passed by DRFC allowing the increase/decrease for the aforesaid year, then the proportionate quantum will be added/deducted in the fees that will be finalised/approved by the EPTA for the A.Y. 2022-23 and 2023-24.

Though the above increase of fees has been approved by the EPTA, in case of any difficulty in resumption and conducting of physical classes in the school, the School Management shall consider granting waiver of 2% in fees. The said waiver is being offered considering the experience, relating to utilization of various facilities services, etc. during the previous period of COVID-19 pandemic.
